Worship Coordinator

Responsible for organizing and managing the nightly worship. Will work with the speaker and worship leader to create cohesive and consistent worship services.

Program Coordinator

Responsible for all small groups, games, and general fun stuff. Also in charge of encouraging and motivating students to serve at a high level.

Media Coordinator

Responsible for all pictures, videos, and social media. Collects and organizes stories from students and leaders. Also manages the M25 Twitter account.

Administrative Coordinator

Ensures all the day-to-day details are taken care of. Assists the director in resolving issues that come up and delegates tasks to the rest of the staff. Responsible for making sure things run smoothly and when a need arises, this person is the first to fill that need.

All Positions

Accompany groups to worksites and fulfill any needs that arise. Responsible for ensuring the cleanliness of both church facilities and worksites. Expected to maintain healthy and professional relationships with other members of the staff and with leaders and students participating in the camps.
